BERNIE CAMP GROUPS and PRICING

YELADIM (CHILDREN): ENTERING GRADES 1 - 3

Yeladim groups give our youngest campers the opportunity to explore a bit of everything Bernie Camp has to offer. Our Yeladim campers enjoy field trips, arts and crafts, sports, music, Israeli culture, and workshops with on-site visitors. Yeladim campers also participate in swim lessons and open swim time, Morning Circle, Shabbat, Friendship Circle, and Friday activities!

OMANUT (ART): ENTERING GRADES 4 - 6

Omanut campers have an enriched art experience in addition to all that Bernie Camp has to offer. On top of swimming, field trips, sports, music, and Israeli culture, Omanut campers collaborate on a session-long art project.

MISCHAK (SPORTS): ENTERING GRADES 4 - 6

Mischak campers have an athletic-focused experience at Bernie Camp. In addition to arts and crafts, field trips, music, and Israeli culture, Mischak campers compete in group games, take hikes in the surrounding areas, learn about social and leadership skills as they relate to games and good sportsmanship.

MADDA (SCIENCE): ENTERING GRADES 4-6

Madda campers have a STEM-focused experience at Bernie Camp. In addition to swimming, arts and crafts, field trips, music, and Israeli culture, Madda campers work through various STEM-related activities designed to expand the curiosities found in science, technology, engineering, and math.

EXPLORERS: ENTERING GRADES 7 - 10

New this year! Now open to teens going into 10th grade!

Explorers are campers who are entering grades 7-10 in the upcoming school year. Explorers have a very different camp experience from the rest of Bernie Camp because they spend their days offsite. They participate in outdoor sporting activities, various “on-theme” field trips, volunteering, community service activities, and while at the J they develop camp counselor skills by helping lead the younger groups in small activities. They are able to swim at the JCC’s beautiful outdoor pool following shorter excursions.

During Session 3, Explorers are only scheduled for two weeks of Bernie Camp, but can participate in Teva – an off-site, week-long, overnight camping experience for students entering grades 7-10. **There is no Explorers camp July 27 – 31 due to Teva. Teva requires a separate registration.**

NEW OPTION! BERNIE BY THE WEEK

We’re excited to announce a brand-new enrollment option for our upcoming summer season, created in response to your valuable feedback!

For the past five years, our camp has operated on a sessions-based model, with families enrolling in one, two, or all three of our summer sessions—each lasting 3 to 4 weeks. This model will continue to be our primary structure for Bernie Camp and the only option for Camp K’Ton Ton. As in previous years, session enrollment is a commitment to the full session, regardless of attendance, and tuition is not pro-rated for absences such as family travel or vacations.

This summer, we’re offering a limited number of weekly registrations for families who need more flexibility. Here’s what to know:

- Bernie by the week will open on April 20, five weeks after full-session enrollment opens.
- Space is limited for weekly enrollment and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Weekly rates will be higher per week than the session rate, to reflect the added flexibility.

Enrolling in a full session guarantees your child’s spot; ***weekly enrollment options will fluctuate and spots may not be available for your preferred week nor is it guaranteed that your child will be placed in the same group each week.***

We’re thrilled to offer this added flexibility and hope it will better serve families with changing summer plans. However, please note that we may not be able to accommodate all requests for weekly enrollment due to space limitations. If securing a spot is a priority, we strongly encourage enrolling in a full session.

BERNIE CAMP SWIM

Children enrolled in Bernie Camp swim three days a week, with each session consisting of a swim lesson portion and an open swim portion. This program is based on the Starfish Aquatics Institute Swim School Curriculum. At the start of each session, campers will undergo a swim assessment and be placed in the appropriate level group based on the demonstrated skills. All children will participate in swim time unless they have a doctor's note limiting their participation.

DROP OFF and PICK UP

Pick up and drop off for Bernie Camp happens curbside on the west side of the parking lot in front of the Activity Center.

Drop off: M - F 8:15 - 8:45 AM A Bernie Camp staff member brings the clipboard to your driver side window for you to sign your child in, then helps your camper unload from your car and walks them to their group. After 8:45 AM you must walk your child into the Camp Office and check them in. You may be asked to walk your child to their group to join the camp day, as our staff may not be available to escort children at the time of your arrival. The Camp Office is located in the Activity Center.

Pick up: Monday - Thursday by 3:45 PM | Friday by 2:45 PM

As cars arrive, Camper Cards should be hanging from the rearview mirror for easy legibility. The campers' names are radioed to the groups, and your camper is brought out to your car and signed out for the day. Please contact the Camp Office if you are picking your child up early. The last 10 minutes of the camp day are very busy with transitions and we cannot guarantee that your child will be brought out to you before the pick-up time. You may not pick up your child from an off-site fieldtrip. In the event you need to pick up early on your child's field trip day, your child will remain onsite at the JCC and join another camp group for that day.

ACTIVITIES

CKT provides a safe and healthy environment where your child can socialize, explore, and create.

Our 2s group enjoys water play twice a week on our toddler playground. They engage in daily science, art, sensory experiences, gardening, and special guests/activities each Friday. Our 2s group is designed only for children currently enrolled in the ECC.

Our 3s group explores water twice a week in our outdoor pool! Each 40-minute session is led by friendly swim instructors, lifeguards and supported by our camp counselors. We focus on helping our youngest campers feel comfortable and safe in and around the water. We start every session with an age-appropriate safety tip followed by joyful water play and discovery.

In keeping with Utah Health Department and JCC Pool guidelines, children age 3 and under are required to wear a reusable swim diaper during pool time. Disposable swim diapers are not allowed. In addition to swim, our 3s engage in hands-on science, art, and sensory explorations, plus gardening, hiking, and exciting activities or special guests every Friday.

Our 4s group is for children entering Pre-K. These brave campers dive into adventure and connection! They swim twice a week in the JCC pool, where each 40-minute session is led by friendly swim instructors, lifeguards, and supported by our awesome counselors. Safety comes first as we learn tips and skills like floating, kicking, and—of course—having fun with open swim and water play!

Our 5s group is for children entering kindergarten. Our confident campers dive into summer fun—literally! Our campers swim four times a week in the JCC pool, learning water safety, floating, kicking, and splashing with confidence. Each session begins with a safety tip and plenty of smiles, led by our friendly swim instructors, lifeguards, and counselors.

The fun doesn't stop at the pool for our 4s and 5s—each week includes afternoon field trips, hands-on science, art, sensory explorations, gardening, hiking, and special guests every Friday.

We offer supervised early-morning and early-evening care for CKT campers at the JCC. Space is limited. You must sign up for Extended Care when you register for camp sessions.

CAMP K'TON TON FAQs

DO YOU HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF THE JCC TO ATTEND CKT?

CKT registration does not require a JCC family membership. However, if you would like to be a member then joining online is easy! Learn more about joining the JCC at slcjcc.org/join.

HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE TO ATTEND CKT?

CKT is for children two years old* (by June 1, 2026) through kindergarten (entering in the Fall of 2026). For children entering 1st grade or above, please see Bernie Camp options on page 6.

*2s group is only for children currently enrolled in ECC

ARE THERE ANY DAYS CAMP IS CLOSED?

There is no camp on June 19 and July 24. There is no PM Extended on June 25 due to our annual fundraiser, Shalom on the Range.

WHAT DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BRING TO CAMP EACH DAY?

Water bottle, kosher style and nut-free lunch, sunscreen (applied before camp), extra clothes, closed-toed shoes, backpack, swimsuit on swim day or water day, **reusable swim diaper for children ages 3 and under on swim day**, towel for swim or water days, crib sheet and blanket for rest time. Please label all items.

DOES CKT PROVIDE FOOD FOR MY CHILD?

We provide a kosher-style and nut-free morning and afternoon snack at summer camp.

To comply with the State of Utah licensing standards, all snacks we provide must be comprised of two or more of the following: meat or meat alternate; vegetable or fruit; bread or bread alternate; milk, juice, or water. Snacks are listed on calendars but are subject to change depending on availability and if birthday treats are served that day. Families may choose to provide additional snacks for their children.

DOES CKT PROVIDE SNACK FOR MY CHILD DURING PM EXTENDED?

No, but families may choose to provide additional snacks for their children.

WHAT FORMS AND DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED TO FINALIZE CAMP REGISTRATION?

In accordance with the Utah Department of Health, an up-to-date copy of your child's immunization record must be on file before your camper's registration is complete. The JCC requires all children to be fully vaccinated to attend our programs. For questions, please email eccadmin@slcjcc.org.

CAN I DROP OFF MY CAMPER AFTER 9:00 AM?

If you are running late, please call the ECC at (801)581-0097 to check when the next drop-off window will be. After 9:00 a.m. it is possible that your child's camp group will be offsite and you will need to wait until they return.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF MY CAMPER IS SICK?

Please call the ECC front desk at (801) 581-0097 to report illness/symptoms and to let your camp counselor know that your child will be out.

CKT ILLNESS POLICY

Children exhibiting any active symptoms of illness or infection at sign-in or during the day must be excluded from camp, not only to help your child recover, but to minimize the spread of infection. Please ensure we have all necessary phone numbers to reach you as well as phone numbers for those listed on your emergency contact form. We require that children are picked up immediately. If children experience diarrhea, they must be excluded from swim for 10 days per the health department and JCC guidelines.

AFTER-CAMP SWIM OPTIONS

GROUP SWIM LESSONS (AGE 3+)

This program is based on the Starfish Aquatics Institute Swim School Curriculum. Swimmers learn in- and out-of-water safety skills, focusing on basic swim skills and aiming to be water-safe at the end of the program. Upper levels work towards competency in freestyle to prepare swimmers to move up to Jr. Jellies.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Ages:

- For swimmers 3 years and older
- 3-year-olds must wear a reusable swim diaper until their 4th birthday (per Health Department and JCC policy) and must have an authorized guardian on deck for the entire lesson

Class Schedule:

- Held **twice weekly** between 3:15 p.m. and 6 p.m. (Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs)
- Class and level offerings are subject to change at the discretion of the Aquatics Department to meet participant needs and ensure appropriate group placement

Assessments:

- On the first day, instructors assess swimmers to make sure they're in the right level. Classes or levels may be adjusted as needed to support each swimmer's success

What to Pack:

- Swimsuit, goggles, and a towel
- If your child swims with camp on the same day as lessons, please pack two swimsuits and two towels

Changing Policy: No changing (clothes or diapers) on deck. Please use the locker rooms or family changing rooms near the indoor pool

SWIM LESSON LEVELS

GROUP LESSONS ARE BASED ON THE STARFISH AQUATICS INSTITUTE

Level 1 Trust and Submersion

For swimmers not yet comfortable underwater. Focuses on relaxed submersion, safe water entry, and always asking permission before swimming.

Level 2 Body Position and Air Recovery

For swimmers who can go underwater. Focuses on floating, bobbing, basic kicking, and safe lifejacket use.

Level 3 Forward Movement and Direction Change

For swimmers who can float independently but cannot yet tread water. Introduces beginner strokes, direction changes, and swim-roll-swim skills.

Level 4 Streamlines and Body Rotation

For swimmers who can tread water but not yet side-roll while kicking. Develops streamline kicks, side breathing, and basic rescue assists.

Level 5 Water Competency

For swimmers who can side-roll kick but not breathe bilaterally. Strengthens swim-roll-swim technique, treading endurance, and safety recovery before advancing to Jr. Jellies.

NOTE: We do our best to staff extra instructors to accommodate waitlisted children, so please add your name to the waitlist even if the class is full!



CAMP TO AFTER-CAMP TRANSITIONS AVAILABLE

CAMP K'TON TON

Children must be at least 4 years old to be transitioned from camp to swim lessons

3:15 PM lessons: Children are automatically transitioned to the pool

Lessons after 4:00 PM: Child must be enrolled in extended care

Aquatics staff cannot return swimmers to extended care after lessons. An authorized guardian must pick up child from the pool deck when the lesson ends.

BERNIE CAMP

3:30 and 4:00 PM lessons: Children are transitioned to the pool by instructors

- If not enrolled in extended care, pickup is at 4:00 p.m. on the indoor pool deck
- If enrolled in extended care, swimmers are returned to camp after lessons
